

Oozing in breed type, this stunning brindle bitch was a pleasure to go over and even more so to watch move. Soft, feminine, well-balanced head,



dark eye, without a hint of haw, correctly undershot jaw and a well-padded muzzle. Lovely reach of neck on a super straight front and strong pasterns. Deep chest and good spring of rib. Adequate tuck up and an excellent top line. Strong, well-muscled hindquarters with lovely angulation, giving her that strong, sure-footed movement.

**RBIM: Cook's Boese Jiggerlotti.** Another quality brindle bitch with lots to like. Beautifully balanced on the stack and another with that typical Boxer movement. Feminine head, dark eye, wide open nostrils and that heart melting expression. Lovely front, level top line and super rear angulation.

**BPIM: Hawkins' Mellhawk Jiggerlicious.** Super cute youngster with another feminine head. Dark eyes, lovely open nostrils, correctly undershot and a well padded muzzle. Correctly set ears which she used when alerted. Lovely profile, straight front and good rear quarters. Once settled, she was solid on the move, reaching out in front.

**BVIM: Lay & Taylor's, Izzamoor Athena At Wivendene.** I was very impressed by the quality of the veterans, this one just had the edge on the day. Cracking head with dark, intelligent eye, well padded muzzle and a super ear set. Well muscled neck, good should placement, straight front and catlike feet. Correct top line, good tuck up and strong well angulated hindquarters. Another solid mover covering the ground effortlessly.

Many thanks for inviting me to judge the 'Dog of the Year 2024' final. I thoroughly enjoyed myself.

## **Dog of the Year: Peck and Ames' Winuwuk Line of Duty for Enesha.**

Brindle dog with excellent top line and tail set. Tight feet, good quarters, true front and clean over shoulders, all combine to give a very pleasing outline, topped by a very good, clean head with correct ratio of muzzle to skull. Appealing expression.

## **Reserve Dog of the Year: Lock's Romanico Bacctu Clarricks JW.**

Brindle bitch with excellent outline, tight feet, strong quarters, correct tail set and true front. Pleasing head with well carried ears and appealing expression. Close decision between these two,

## **Puppy of the Year: Longley's Limkyns Moonlight Tango with Attomic.**

Red bitch with excellent outline and correct top line (which she held on the move). Correct tail set, feet and a straight true front with clean, well angulated shoulders. Well balanced head with correct muzzle to skull ratio and dark expressive eyes. Moved well when seen from all angles.

## **Reserve Puppy of the Year: Hawkins' Mellhawk Jiggerlicious.**

Brindle bitch with pleasing outline, good front and clean over shoulders. Attractive, well-balanced head with appealing expression from dark, well-shaped eyes and correct ear carriage.

## **Veteran of the Year: Taylor and Lay's Izzamoor Athena At Wivendene.**

Compact brindle bitch with well angulated 'hammy' quarters, correct top line and tail set, good front, clean shoulders. Pretty well balanced head with dark expressive eyes and a broad muzzle which has not coarsened over the years.

## **Reserve Veteran of the Year: Peck's Manic Keep it Real for Enesha.**

Brindle dog with pleasing outline, tight feet, good top line, tail set and front. Correct ear carriage, balanced head proportions and pleasing expression.

**BIM: Merritt's Diceulon Top Hat & Tails at Merquin.** Impressive, 21 mths, dark brindle dog, 4 white socks, masculine head, broad muzzle, well padded lips, distinct stop, amiable dark brown eye, plenty of desirable black pigment throughout, jaw is undershot and has full dentition, stands square, well balanced, plenty of bone, substance and muscle, stands square, good hind angulation showing off his muscular rear, broad croup, a powerhouse, sound free mover with plenty of pizzazz and ring presence. Full of quality.

**RBIM: Lock's Romanico Bacctu Clarricks JW** classic beauty, 2 yrs bitch with rich brindle glossy coat having herringbone pattern on back, very desirable. 4 flashy white socks and white blaze. Femme head with expressive bold dark brown eyes, thin wide set ears on top of skull, undershot jaw with desired dentition. She's fit and muscular throughout having a good balance of bone and substance. A positive free sound mover. Plenty of promise.

**BPIM: Mitchell's Diceulon Lulahmitz Suprise Suprise** 10 mths baby girl, brindle, eye catching with 4 white socks, blaze collar and chest. She's femme and has a keen twinkling eye, desirable dark pigments throughout, typical undershot jaw and clean dentition. Standing square you see her long slope of shoulder and deep chest. Plenty of reach and drive, sound each way. A really lovely baby, already has many pleasing breed traits. An exciting prospect.

**BIM:** Kuech's Boese Jiggery Pokery this 6 year old brindle bitch just grabbed my heart. She oozes breed type her confirmation is excellent and one of the few that had height of foreleg which I have noticed we are losing in the breed. Super well balanced head lovely dark eye and excellent width of muzzle. She moved true, front and rear, one I could have easily taken home (although I don't think the Pugs would have approved).

**RBIM & BPIM:** Hawkins' Mellhawk Jiggerlicious. Quality 9-month brindle and white bitch that turns out to be a granddaughter of my BIM. Again a lovely balanced head with no exaggeration. Lovely outline when stacked. Moved and showed well I wouldn't be surprised if this one gets to the "upper house".

**BIM: Lock's Romanico Bacctu Clarricks JW.** Beautifully put together girl of good size. Lovely balanced head with expressive ears and soft expression. I really liked her front assembly and fore chest. Good reach of neck with nice arch to well-laid shoulders and slightly sloping top line. I would like a little more substance to her back end but she has lovely angles and moved with nice strong hocks in straight lines.

**RBIM: Peck & Ames Winuwuk line of duty for Enesha.** Handsome flashy lad. Well up to size. Lovely square shape with sloping top line. Strong head with neat ears. Strong neck to well laid shoulders. I'd like a little longer upper arm. Great depth of chest and length of rib. Solid short loin to powerful hind quarters. Moved well on tight feet.

**BPIM: Jinks' Farvalley Sunshine at Stangard.** Very friendly puppy of nice size with good bone. Good length of muzzle with nice head planes and proportions. Good depth of chest and evident fore chest. Nice rear angles. Lots of maturing to do.

**BVIM: Keep it Real for Enesha.** Super lad of excellent type. Great shape and condition. Still has solid sound movement and great top line. I'd take him home.

**BBPIM: Wheeler's Hipkins Charismatic.** Lovely puppy and one to watch. Super head shape and expression, Already has a lovely elegant shape with a confident stance. Taking it all in her stride.

Good arch of neck leading into correct top line and well set tail. Overall presented an elegant outline with sufficient bone and correct front and rear angulation. On the move she was very sound with good stride and lovely foot placement. I loved her!

**RBIM & BV: Peck's Manic Keep it Real For Enesha**. So good to see such a super veteran male. Hard to credit his age as he is so fit and well-conditioned. His muzzle frosting might hint at his longevity, but nothing detracts. Strong, masculine body, good bone and feet, correct angulation. Lovely top line which was maintained both on the stand and on the move. Moving he is very sound, showing reach and drive. Super boy!

**BPIM: Wheeler's Hipkins Charismatic**. Very attractive dark brindle. A 7 months (I hope I have this right), is just a baby with so much more to come, but already showing good type and confidence. Lovely square outline, nice for bone and with lovely feet. Moved out well. Lovely pup!

A final word on the very talented and very young junior handler, **Isla**, who showed with such confidence and sympathetic handling of her baby puppy, followed my instructions well, and kept a close watch on her charge. Was so impressed and hope that she has a lot of fun showing for many years to come.



# The Animal PoisonLine

## Vital Information for Pet Owners

Sheena recently attended a presentation at her veterinary practice and thought this information could be very useful for club members.

Poisons can affect animals in many ways. They may act after being **eaten, spilled on the skin, splashed into the eyes, inhaled**, or even **injected**. Pets can become unwell after exposure to all sorts of everyday items, including **human and veterinary medicines, pesticides, plants and fungi, venomous animals, household or garden products, human foods, cosmetics, and toiletries**.

### What is the Animal PoisonLine?

The **Animal PoisonLine** is a service run by the **Veterinary Poisons Information Service (VPIS)**.

Based on the information you provide, their vets and scientists can advise whether your pet needs immediate veterinary treatment, or if you can safely manage the situation at home. In their experience, **more than half of the cases they receive can stay at home** with monitoring and reassurance.

If your pet does need to see a vet, please be aware that your veterinary practice may charge a fee if they need to call VPIS for detailed guidance.

### Information You Will Need When Calling

Have the following details ready to help the team give accurate advice:

- ◆ Your pet's **breed, age, weight, sex, and name**
- ◆ **What** your pet has been exposed to – the drug, plant, food, or product name
- ◆ **How** exposure occurred – eaten, inhaled, on the skin, etc.
- ◆ The **amount** involved and **how long ago** it happened
- ◆ Whether this is the **first time** or a **repeated exposure**

### What to Do if You Think Your Pet Has Been Poisoned

1. Call Animal PoisonLine to confirm whether any action is needed.
2. If your pet has vomited, clean it up promptly to stop other pets or children from being exposed.
3. If there is contamination on fur or skin, gently wipe off any excess material.
4. Do not try to make your pet vomit and never give salt water.
5. If advised to visit the vet, take a sample of the suspected poison – such as packaging, container, or plant material – as this will help with diagnosis and treatment.

The Animal PoisonLine operates **24 hours a day** and can offer fast, practical advice at what is often a very worrying time.






